

EXHIBITOR RULES:

1. Name, address and phone number should be on each item before it is entered. Also, this information should be in a place where the judges can't see it during judging.
2. If a kit was used please note that on the item.
3. If exhibiting a recycled or re-engineered item, please describe the item or process on a card and attach it to the exhibit.
4. Mount jewelry or small items on a mat, foam board or appliance for display.
5. Bring garments on hangers.
6. All scrapbook entries except Best Scrapbook should be in clear plastic. They should be mounted whereas the double page layout should not exceed 12 x 24 and on something to keep them from bending.
7. All photography entries should be mounted on mat board. No frames will be accepted. All classes except snapshots must be at least 5x7, and up to a 16x20. Fair reserves the right to refuse to hang any picture deemed not suitable for public viewing.
8. Art entries - that are not framed or are on canvas, must be mounted on a mat board or such. All entries must have the proper means to be hung for exhibition.
9. All canned entries must be in standard canning jars and have standard canning lids and rings and must be properly sealed. Names & phone # on bottom please.
10. Dried items must be in zip lock bags, up to one quart size.
11. The Rhea County Fair is not responsible for breakage, spoilage or theft.
12. All entries not claimed after release date will become property of the Rhea County Fair.
13. Culinary Art exhibits other than cake decorating should be in disposable containers. Recipes should accompany the entries.
